Dates: June 8-12, 2009

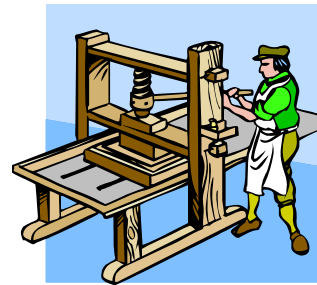

DeBary Hall's Game Quest

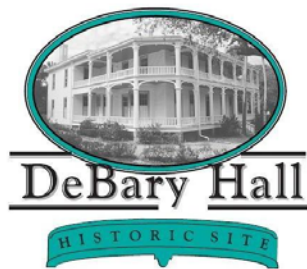
Dates: July 27-31, 2009
